

OA Recheck Checklist

The goal of this checklist is to track response to therapy and identify any potential concerns as early as possible. Concerns may or may not be related to prescribed treatments, but should be addressed by a veterinarian prior to continuing with the current plan. New lameness or mobility concerns should prompt veterinary examination and may indicate that the working diagnosis is incomplete and/or current therapy is insufficient.

Be sure to address each item prior to administering OA medication or refilling Rx. Place a check mark to indicate each question has been asked.
